Dorset Blue Vinny

Made to a three-hundred-year-old recipe, Dorset Blue Vinny is made from unpasteurised cow's milk and vegetarian rennet. Traditionally, old anchors and chains would be pulled through the milk to encourage the blue veins in the cheese. Fortunately, this element of the cheese making process is left out. Dorset Blue Vinny is a gentle blue with a mild sweetness

Wigmore

Wigmore is a multi-award-winning sheep's milk cheese from Berkshire. It is a traditional hand-made washed curd cheese, which is a method rarely used in the UK, Washing the curds reduces the number of starter bacteria and sugars present in the milk, which leads to a milder acidity in the finished cheese. The milk is thermised rather than pasteurised, to help preserve the milks delicate flavours, which are fresh, clean and slightly sweet

Cornish Yarg (Nettle covered)

Named after the couple who first handmade this Cornish cheese in the 1970s (it is their surname, Gray, spelt backwards), this is a beautiful example of British artisan cheese. Wrapped in nettle or garlic leaves, the hard, tangy-tasting cheese has been the recipient of a shelf-full of awards.

Barbers vintage mature Cheddar

Barber's Farmhouse Vintage Cheddar is made with traditional starter cultures, West Country milk and using age-old methods, it's typically matured for 18 months. Full-bodied and complex.

PORT

Taylors LBV £4.25
Late Bottled Vintage, as the name suggests,
is bottled later, remaining in wood between four
and six years. During this relatively long period
of wood ageing, an LBV matures and settles
down - it is ready to drink when bottled.

Taylors 10yr old £6.00
A classic 10 year old Tawny port from
top producers Taylor's. This is a robust,
delicious wine which pairs wonderfully
with soft cheese or dishes made with
almond or coffee.

Taylors 20yr old £8.50
This rich, mellow, old tawny port owes
its intense complex nose to many years
of ageing in oak casks. This port makes a
delicious dessert wine and is the perfect
finish to any meal.
